GENERAL INFORMATION

1. All associate **degree and undergraduate** students enrolled in our departments may apply for Student Traineeship Mobility.
2. In order to apply, the Grade Point Average (GPA) must be at least **2.20**.
3. Applications will be submitted through the **Turkish National Agency Erasmus Application Portal** by logging in with an **e-Government username and password**.
4. Within the framework of the budget allocated to our institution, grant support can be provided to a total of **10** students. In order to ensure equal distribution of grants, each student will receive grant support for **2 months**.
5. In the final evaluation list, each student will be ranked according to their score in comparison with applicants from their own department. In the event that candidates from the same department have equal scores, priority will be given to the student with the higher academic achievement score; if the academic achievement scores are also equal, priority will be given to the younger student.

6. Selected students must complete their traineeship between **01 July 2026 and 31 August 2026.**
7. **International Students:** The “Republic of Türkiye Residence Permit Document” and the personal information page of your passport must be uploaded to the application page. Students whose residence permit validity covers the period between **01.07.2026 and 31.08.2026** may apply. The front and back sides of the Residence Permit Document must be uploaded as a single PDF file to the system. The relevant page of the passport must be uploaded as a separate PDF file.
8. The traineeship placement must be arranged by the student.



1. In case a student who has been selected for Traineeship Mobility fails to participate without submitting a withdrawal notice within the prescribed period, except for force majeure (e.g., visa refusal), a deduction of **-10** points will be applied in the event of a subsequent Erasmus+ mobility application.

Applicants or their first-degree relatives who have received disaster relief from AFAD	+10 point
Applying within the scope of a mandatory internship	+5 point
Internships aimed at developing digital skills (DOTs) are given priority.	+5 point
Previous participation in the same type of project (with or without grant)	-10 point
Participation in mobility in the country of citizenship	-10 point
Being selected for mobility but not participating without timely withdrawal notification (applies if the student reapplies for Erasmus)	-10 point
Applying for both study and internship mobility at the same time (a reduction is applied to the mobility type chosen by the student)	-10 point

For students selected for mobility: Not attending meetings/trainings organized by the higher education institution regarding mobility without a valid excuse (applies if the student reapplies for Erasmus)	-5 point
Declaring intention to take the language exam but not attending without a valid excuse (applies if the student reapplies for Erasmus)	-5 point

1. Traineeships involving one or more of the following activities are considered within this scope: digital marketing (e.g., social media management, web analytics); digital graphic, mechanical and architectural design; application, software and code or website development; installation, maintenance and management of information systems and networks; cybersecurity; data analytics, data mining and visualization; programming, robotics, and artificial intelligence training. General customer service, lead generation, data entry, or routine office duties are not considered within this scope.
2. This is applied only once. If the student is selected, it will not be applied in subsequent applications. If the student is not selected, the additional points will continue to be applied in future applications.

The application evaluation criteria have been determined in accordance with the 2025 Implementation Handbook for Higher Education Student and Staff Mobility between Programme Countries and Partner Countries.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

1. Students who will participate in **Erasmus+ Student Traineeship** Mobility are required to apply with a **Foreign Language exam** result at the time of application.
2. The foreign language minimum threshold score for applicants is set **at 60** points for all associate degree and undergraduate students.
3. Students may participate in the Erasmus+ Foreign Language Exam to be organized by the School of Foreign Languages on **10 March 2026**. The exam measures Reading/Use of Language, Listening, and Writing skills. (Preparatory class exemption exams are not valid.) Students planning to take this exam must select the option “I will take the exam organized by the university” via the Turna Portal system during the application process.
4. Applications may also be submitted with results from previously administered Erasmus+ Foreign Language Exams conducted by our University or with exam results recognized as equivalent by the Council of Higher Education (such as TOEFL). The relevant exam result documents must be uploaded to the system in PDF format during application.
5. The validity period of Erasmus+ Foreign Language Exam results previously conducted by our University is **3 years**. In applications, the most recent exam result taken by the student will be considered.
6. Students who fail to obtain the required minimum score in the language exam conducted by our institution will not be evaluated.

TRAINEESHIP ACCEPTANCE LETTER

1. The Traineeship Acceptance Letter must be related to the student’s field of study.
2. Although the Traineeship Acceptance Letter is not mandatory at the application stage, candidates who upload an acceptance letter to the system during application will receive +10 points.
3. The Traineeship Acceptance Letter must include the authorized person of the host institution, full address, e-mail address, telephone number, and similar contact details.
4. Acceptance letters without a stamp/seal and signature will not be evaluated.
5. Acceptance letters whose authenticity cannot be verified will not be evaluated.
6. Students who receive additional points by submitting a Traineeship Acceptance Letter may only carry out their traineeship at the institution specified in that letter after being selected.

GRANT

1. Students participating in Erasmus+ Student Traineeship Mobility will receive monthly financial support for the period spent abroad.
2. Students who are not allocated a grant may withdraw from the program or choose to participate with a **“zero grant.”**
3. Grant payments are made in two installments. 80% of the total grant amount is paid before departure, and the remaining 20% is transferred to the student’s account after return.
4. The table of individual support grant amounts applicable to students going to Programme Countries is provided below.
